C. It's About People, Not Programs: Leveraging Support to Build Principal Capacity

Emerging from the pandemic has presented immense challenges for districts everywhere, and Clark County, NV (CCSD) - 5th largest district in the country - is no exception. How, then, could the district best meet the needs of its schools serving some of the most at-risk populations to rise to the challenge and beat the odds? District leaders and a partner organization, NWEA, have designed an innovative approach by providing through-year, differentiated, and embedded professional learning supports to principals with the goal of building capacity and yielding improvements to student learning outcomes. Learn the key features of the support provided, how it has been implemented effectively, and what gains have resulted from these efforts.

D. Mindful Leadership and Equitable Approaches for Healthier School Communities

Join to learn how district leaders from across the country are leveraging various resources to create equitable approaches to identify, intervene and serve mental health needs in their communities. Care Solace will spotlight promising practices and mental health models from district partners and encourage participants to share their strategies for improving mental health in our schools, communities, and ourselves. Hear how Care Solace helps districts address mental health needs that exceed the scope or schedule of school-based services, including staff and family wellness. Our session will be Interactive, reflective, and experiential. We will utilize a variety of adult learning theory methods to engage the participants, including discussion and collaboration around problems of practice. The presenters will also share case studies with promising practices from school systems across the country and invite participants to share their knowledge and expertise with each other. We will make all the materials accessible to participants before and after the session.

E. Great Boards, "Connectedness equates to Effectiveness"




